Distribution: common and widespread in Wisconsin

Health Concerns: Lyme Disease, Babesiosis, Anaplasmosis, Powassan Virus, and others

American Dog Tick (Dermacentor variabilis) Also known as the "wood tick"



Distribution: common and widespread in Wisconsin **Health Concerns**: Rocky Mountain Spotted Fever, Tularemia

Lone Star Tick (Amblyomma americanum)



Distribution: rarely encountered in Wisconsin; report to UW Insect Diagnostic Lab Health Concerns: Human Ehrlichiosis, Tularemia, viral diseases, Red-Meat Allergy
